The Practice Assessment in Plastic Surgery (PA-PS) Module and Professional Standing Update are required in years 3, 6 and 9 of your 10 year cycle. The Performance in Practice requirement (review of your practice through a six-month case list with the application) must be completed in years 7, 8 **or** 9 to be followed by the Cognitive Examination in years 8, 9 **or** 10 of your 10 year cycle.
